

Curvy Keepsake Turkey - Headed to France

<u>Paper:</u> Color Me Autumn Designer Series Paper for tail and 2 of 3 wing feathers on each side, Old Olive body, Blackberry Bliss beret, Real Red waddle, Crushed Curry beak

<u>Ink:</u> Blackberry Bliss for sponging the edges

Accessories: Google Eyes

<u>Tools:</u> Big Shot, Curvy Keepsake Framelit, Rosette Bigz Die, Feathers Framelit, Argyle Embossing Folder, Large Oval Punch, Small Oval Punch, Flower Frenzy Bigz Die (or Retired Blossoms Petal Builder Punch), Paper Cutter, Snail Adhesive, Sponge, Glue Gun, Hobby Knife



Body: Using the Curvy Keepsake Box Framelit, cut 2

Wings: Cut two plain paper feathers for layering Between the designer paper feathers

Head & Chest: Use template to cut (see 2nd attachment)

Run the two body parts & head piece through Argyle Embossing Folder



Beret: Punch 2, fussy cut a little triangle for beret tip, use hobby knife to slit beret the right size to slide on head, glue 2nd oval on back.

Beak: Use a blossom of the Flower Frenzy Bigz Die or the Blossom Petal Punch pictured here but retired.

Waddle: Punch the heart and place it on a sticky note to punch a second time.

Rosette: Make 2. Use 4" x 12", place them back to back, hold open and glue to the small oval, both sides.

Wings: Make 2 with DSP, Flip the paper over to make another 2.
