## **Envelope Card Box**

<u>Stamp Sets</u>: Watercolor Wings <u>Paper</u>: Bermuda Bay, Blackberry Bliss, Very Vanilla

Bohemian DSP (Designer Series Paper)

Ink & Markers: Bermuda Bay

<u>Accessories:</u> Very Vintage Designer Button, Bermuda Bay Bakers Twine <u>Tools:</u> Envelope Punch Board, Big Shot, Lots of Labels Framelits,

Glue Dots, Snail Adhesive, Tear and Tape Adhesive

**Envelope Box:** Bohemian DSP 9" X 9"

1. Align left edge at a Score Line measurement of 3 ½" >Notch >Score

2. Move paper left to 4 ½" >Notch >Score

Turn Paper to the opposite side (180 degrees) and repeat steps 1 and 2

- 3. Now turn the paper one direction (90 degrees) and line up the score line created above with the Score Guide >Notch >Score
- 4. Now move it over to the second score line on the same side >Notch >Score

Turn Paper to the opposite side (180 degrees) and repeat steps 3 and 4

5. Cut out the four notches as shown and 1" on wider side flap, round the other points:



**Belly Band:** Bohemian DSP 1 ½ " X 12"

Score at: 2 ¼, 3, 7 ½, 8 ¼ Fold score lines, wrap around box and attach with Tape Just For You Greeting: Very Vanilla Scrap Cut with #2 Lots of Labels Framelit

Buckle  $1^{st}$  Layer: Card Stock  $2\frac{1}{2}$  " X 4" Cut with #5 Framelit Buckle top Layer: DSP 2 " X  $3\frac{1}{4}$  " Cut with the #4 Framelit

Note: Framelits are counted from the smallest #1 to the largest #7
