<u>Stamp Sets</u>: Get Well Soup <u>Paper</u>: Very Vanilla, Bohemian DSP, Thoughts & Pravers Bermuda Bay

Ink & Markers: Tuxedo Black Memento Ink, Smoky Slate with the Blender pen for shadows,

Crushed Curry Marker for coloring the soup, fine tip colored unevenly for

nice "soupy" look

Accessories: Bermuda Bay Thick Baker's Twine 8"

<u>Tools:</u> Blender Pen, Big Shot, Oval Collection Framelit, Snail Adhesive, Liquid Glue, Glue Dots, Dimensionals, Cutting Tools, Scrap of Post It Note for masking

Main Card: Bermuda Bay 5 ½ " X 8 ½ " Score at 4 ¼ "

Optional 1st Layer: Very Vanilla 5 3/8 " X 4 1/8 " This will be used for stamping the

(oval top layer)

This will be used for stamping the whole image & cutting with the oval. It was not used as a layer in the first card shown above.

DSP Layer: Bohemian DSP 4" X 5 ¼ "

Soup Bowl: Bohemian DSP 3" X 3"

Inside Layer:: Very Vanilla 4" X 5 ¼ "

Strip on inside: Bohemian DSP 3/4" X 4"







- Stamp the image on the Very Vanilla layer
- Mask the heart on the soup bowl with the scrap of Post It Note, ink the stamp, then remove the post it note before stamping, stamp on 3 X 3 DSP
- Snip the right side of the bowl and cut out the soup portion of bowl, glue bowl to the image on the Very Vanilla using liquid glue so you can adjust to fit, color soup
- Using the second from the largest Oval Framelit (#6) cut out the image and pop it up with dimensionals on your DSP
- Use a blender pen and the Smokey Slate Ink to create steamy shadows on the words and a shadow at the base of the bowl. Add a Baker's Twine bow to the top. SAL
