

Gift Card Slider Card

A Pinecone Press Creation Repurposed for Stampers

<u>Stamp Set</u>: Versatile Christmas <u>Paper</u>: Whisper White, Real Red,

Pear Pizzaz, Merry Moments DSP

Ink: Pear Pizzaz Ink

Accessories: Pear Pizzaz Ribbon, Old Olive Baker's Twine, Clear Envelope for slider sleeve

<u>Tools:</u> Ovals Collection Framelits Dies, 1 ¼" Circle Punch, Curvy Corner Trio Punch, Big Shot, Adhesives & Cutting Tool

Main Card: Pear Pizzaz 11 7/8" X 6"; Score at 2 7/8", 3 ¼", 6 1/8", 6 ½", 9 3/8"

(2) Inside Slider Cards: Real Red 2 5/8" X 5 ½"

Envelope Band: Clear Envelope ; Cut $1\frac{1}{2}$ " of the envelope to make a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X $4\frac{3}{8}$ " band Top of box: Merry Moments DSP $2\frac{3}{4}$ " X $5\frac{3}{4}$ "


- (2) Strips for bottom of the inside sliders: Merry Moments DSP 5 ½" X ¼"
- (2) Greetings: Whisper White 3 3/4" X 2 3/4"

Frames for greetings: Pear Pizzaz 4 X 3 ¼" Layer 3 ovals to cut both frames- same piece

Gift Box: Merry Moments DSP 1 1/2" X 2"

Pear Pizzaz Ribbon: 2" length and 2 ½" length to wrap box; 4" length for the pull

Old Olive Baker's Twine: 6" for bow on box, 3" to tie the ribbon for the pull



4 ¼" Width for slider sleeve

Score: 2.7/8; 3.4 6.1/8" 6.1/8" 6.1/8" 9.3/8" With a pencil make a small dot 7/8" in from the top and bottom and 1/2" from 9.3/8" score line. Cut to the dot at an angle and then cut to the end.

Using the 1 ¼" circle punch, punch 1/3 depth on bottom, top and slider sections as shown.

Fold and crease all the score lines in the same direction. Now let's make the sliders!

Cut a $1\ 1/2$ " wide strip of the clear envelope using the $4\ 3/8$ " envelope width with the seams on each side. We will call this the envelope band. Roll the band to position the seams at the top and back so you can apply tape. Use Tear and Tape and apply a $1\ \frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the outside of each seam of the envelope band with the seam in the middle of the tape for reinforcement. Be careful that there is no tape overhang.

Now take one of the two real red inside slider cards and position one seam of the envelope band on the right side of the slider card centering the band vertically on the card with the taped seam about 1/8" from right side. Peel off the Tear and Tape and adhere. Peel off the Tear and Tape on the other envelope band seam and position the second slider card on top of the first but 1/4" over from the left which will put the tape about 1/8" from the left edge. The envelope band is now sandwiched between the two slider cards like this:



You will slip the slider sleeve end of the main card inside this envelope band with the longer right hand side toward the bottom, the punched side, of the main card; refer to the picture on the first page and picture rotating the above picture 90 degrees to the right. When you roll the card into a box this longer side of the sleeves will be on the bottom of the two slider cards. Check your construction. Does it slide?

Place a piece of Tear and Tape on the inside of the far left, bottom card section and starting at the right on the main card, roll the card to the left along the score lines to create a box. Remove the liner of the Tear and Tape and flatten the box to make it attach to the Tape very evenly.

Using the Curvy Corner Trio Punch, punch the end of the long red slider card (should now be the bottom of the two sliders) with the ribbon slide side of the punch. Insert the ribbon and tie with bakers twine.

Stamp your greetings on the Whisper White and cut out with the Oval Framelits. The outside greeting is cut with the #3 oval (counting from the smallest to the largest) and the inside greeting is cut with the #2 oval. Position the greeting toward the top so there is room for signing. Layer three of the Oval Framelits, #2, #3 and #4, on the Pear Pizzaz piece of cardstock and cut both frames at the same time. Adhere to top and right hand slider.

Place your DSP strips on the bottom edge of your slider cards and adhere the matching DSP top section. Punch the edge to match the card stock. For the package I wrapped the rectangle with individual sections of ribbon and then added a Bakers Twine bow to match what I used for the pull. Add your gift card, family picture, doggy picture or to the left slider card. I stamped Merry Christmas in Versa Mark on the left hand slider so when the gift card is removed you still have something on that side.

Envelope: Use the envelope punch board and a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of red envelope paper. Follow instructions on the punch board and then cut the 2 long points at $6\frac{1}{4}$ ".
