Rejoicing - Pocket Card

Cased idea from Dawn Olchefske

Stamp Sets: Versatile Christmas

<u>Paper</u>: Basic Black, Very Vanilla, Real Red, Red Glimmer Paper, Cucumber Crush, DSP, Gold Glimmer Paper Scrap

Ink: Real Red

Accessories: Gold Metallic Thread, 1/8" Striped Red Ribbon

Tools: Flower Flair Framelits (or retired five petal flower punch), Curvy Corner Trio Punch, Corner Rounder Punch, Cupcake Builder Punch for the little circles (or 3/16 hole punch), Stamp-a-ma-jig, Big Shot, Tear and Tape, Dimensionals, Standard Adhesives & Cutting Tools

Main Card: Basic Black 4 ¼" X 11" Scored at 1 ¼" and 5 ½", Corner Round the top, Fold the 1 ¼" down and adhere with dimensionals, Use ½ width Tear and Tape to adhere the sides

Pocket Fold Layer: Red Glimmer Paper 4 1/4" X 1 1/4"

Pocket Fold Top Layer: Designer Series Paper 4" X 1" (I used a retired piece of DSP but the red and white stripe in Home For Christmas DSP would match the ribbon and look great!) Be sure and adhere with Tear and Tape.

Inside Panel: Very Vanilla 3 ½" X 5 ¼", Fancy Corner Punch and add red glimmer dots
Use the Stamp-a-ma-jig to align your greeting so
the "Rejoicing With You" is sticking out of the pocket

Bottom of the Inside Panel: Red Glimmer ¼" X 3 ½" Strip

Poinsettia: Red Envelope Paper 4 ½" X 2" Cut out two, offset petals, attach

Poinsettia Leaf: Cucumber Crush 2 ½" X 2" Cut one flower, cut off two petals, glue one of the cut off petals to one of the three left intact to extend petal so it peeks out from under the flower

2 Red Dots on Panel: Red Glimmer Scrap Punched with the Cupcake Builder Punch (3/16") 3 Gold Dots on Flower: Gold Glimmer Scrap Punched with the Cupcake Builder Punch

1/8" Striped Red Ribbon 10" Not tied, just crossed over in the middle under the flower Gold Thread: 20" Wrapped around four fingers three times. A glue dot to start it on your fingers works great! Adhere to back of leaf with another glue dot. SAL
