



White Christmas Tree

Stamp Sets: Flurry of Wishes, Kinda Eclectic, Petite Pairs

Paper: Night of Navy, Whisper White, Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer, Red Glimmer, Window Sheet

Ink & Markers: Night of Navy ink pad for greetings, and Night of Navy marker for star rays

Accessories: Tea Lace Paper Doilies

Tools: Hearth & Home Thinlits Dies, Perfect Pines Framelits Dies, Project Life Cards & Labels Framelits, Itty Bitty Accents Punch Pack Star, Stylish Stipes Embossing Folder, Bitty Banners Framelits, Cupcake Builder Punch for little circles on greeting, Big Shot, Adhesives & Cutting Tool

Main Card: Night of Navy 5 1/2" X 8 1/2" Score at 4 1/4"

Window Cut Out: Whisper White 3 5/8" X 3 1/8"

1st Layer: Dazzling Diamonds 5 1/4" X 4"

Tree: Dazzling Diamonds cut out of 1st Layer with the Project Life 3 X 4 Rectangle

Red Layer Behind Tree: Red Glimmer Paper 2 1/4" X 2 1/4", scrap for star & small circles

Wall Layer Behind the Tree: Night of Navy 2 3/8" X 2 3/4" Emboss w/ Stylish Stripes EF

Window Sheet: 3 3/16" X 2 3/8"

Inside Layer: Whisper White 3 3/4" X 5"

Strip for greeting on front: 2 3/4" X 1"

Strip for inside left: Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer 1/4" X 5"

- Use the Project Life Framelit to cut out the middle of the Dazzling Diamonds Layer. Use that piece to cut out the tree with the medium size Perfect Pines framelit positioning the little circles framelit inside before running through the Big Shot. Use the smallest tree framelit to cut out the Red glimmer paper to go behind the tree. Cut off the points of the red tree so they don't show. Use the Perfect Pines Framelit star for the star on the top of the tree but use the larger Itty Bitty Accents Punch for the red star on the inside. Use the cupcake punch to punch out two glimmery dots for the greeting. The greeting is stamped with the Merry Christmas from Petite Pairs and then cut out with the Bitty Banners Framelits. The window sheet is attached to the window frame with Tear & Tape (cut in 1/2). The curtains are cut out from the tea lace doilies and attached to the window sheet with glue dots. Be careful to get them right side out! The embossed wall sheet is glued on the main card and then the tree glued to it, star put on top and window popped up with dimensionals. The inside star rays are created by coloring 5 rays of sun from the Kinda Eclectic set with a marker. Mask the adjoining rays with sticky notes for a clean image. Smile A Lot!
