



Flurry of Wishes (Watercoloring on Vellum)

Stamp Sets: Flurry of Wishes,
Any Variety of Greetings to create a “flurry”

Paper: Whisper White, Bermuda Bay,
Card Stock Vellum, Dazzling Diamonds

Ink: Bermuda Bay and its reinker, Versa Mark, White Embossing Powder, Frost White Ink

Accessories: Silver Cording, Bermuda Bay Sequin Trim, Rhinestone

Tools: Snow Flurry Punch, Lots of Labels Framelits, Embossing Buddy, Heat Tool, Big Shot,
Standard Adhesives & Cutting Tools

For Watercoloring on Vellum: Bermuda Bay Reinker, Alcohol (90% dries fastest), Salt,
Paintbrush, Paper Towels, Spritzer filled $\frac{3}{4}$ with alcohol and 20 drops Frost White Ink

Main Card: Whisper White 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Scored at 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ "

1st Layer: Bermuda Bay 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{8}$ "

Inside Layer: Bermuda Bay 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " X 4

Top Outside: Card Stock Vellum 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " X 4"

Inside: Whisper White 5 X 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

Greeting First Layer: Dazzling Diamonds 4" X 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", Use #5 (counting smallest to largest) of
Lots of Labels Framelit to cut. Make two $\frac{1}{4}$ " X $\frac{3}{4}$ " belts for sides with scrap

Greeting Second Layer (2): Bermuda Bay 2" X 7" will make two cut with #4 of framelit.
Since the top is the same size as this layer, make your frame using two #4 cut outs,
laying one on top of the other but over $\frac{1}{8}$ ", and cutting both simultaneously down
the middle. Use top piece of one and bottom piece of the other to make the layer.

Greeting Top: Whisper White 2 X 3 Stamp then cut with #4 framelit

Snowflakes: Whisper White 2 X 3 Stamp then punch snowflakes, use large flake on inside,
small snowflake on outside layered on 6" of Sequin Trim and 4" of silver cording
with a rhinestone on top!

Technique Alert: Watercoloring on Vellum; Video by Stacey Lane at A Work of Carte

Dot Bermuda Bay reinker on your vellum card stock, 8 dots, sprinkle with a cap of rubbing
alcohol, then use a paintbrush to swirl the ink around on the vellum, sprinkle with salt (sea
salt makes larger dots), let the salt sit for several minutes to absorb the ink then spritz the
vellum with a spritzer filled with alcohol and Frost White Ink. I spritzed several times to get
a mottled look. Let dry then wipe with a paper towel to remove the salt.

Use the embossing buddy on the vellum sheet when completely dry (critical) and then
stamp the snowflakes with Versa Mark ink. Emboss with white embossing powder.
Assemble, popping up the greeting with dimensionals. Smile A Lot!
