Punch Art Angel Card

Stamp Sets: Petite Pairs, Every Blessing,

<u>Paper</u>: Whisper White, Red Foil, Scrap Gold Foil, Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer, Blushing Bride, Holiday Fancy Foil Designer Vellum

<u>Ink & Markers:</u> Real Red, Gold Metallic, Black Pen for drawing eyelids/lashes <u>Accessories:</u> Home For Christmas Enamel Dots, Silver Metallic Thread, Tea Lace Doily

<u>Tools:</u> Bow Builder Punch, Star Punch from Itty Bitty Accents Punch Pack, Curvy Corner Trio Punch, 34" Punch, 1" Punch, Owl Punch, Lots of Labels Framelits, Bitty Banners Framelits, Lucky Stars Embossing Folder, Big Shot, Standard adhesives and cutting tools, Sticky note. Optional: Rectangle from Seasonal Frame Thinlits Dies to save paper.

Main Card: Whisper White 4 ¼" X 11" Scored at 5 ½"

1st Layer: Whisper White $3\ 3/4$ " X 5 " Embossed with Lucky Stars embossing folder 2nd Layer: Red Foil 4" X 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Cut out middle with largest of Lots of Labels (#7)

Frame: Diamonds Glimmer 3" X 5" Cut out with Lots of Labels #6 & #7

Inside Layer: Red Foil 4" X 5 1/4" Cut out middle with Seasonal Frame Thinlit die

Inside Top: Whisper White 3 3/4" X 5"

Angel's Dress: Red Striped Fancy Vellum 6" X 6"

Silver Thread: 4 ½" for the ornament hanger; 8" to put under the Red Enamel dot

Scrap of Blushing Bride for head and hands

Halo and Dress decoration: Glimmer Paper 2 ¼" X 1 ¼"

Angel:

Head: Punch a ¾" Blushing Bride circle. Punch two circles of sticky note with the medium size circle of Owl Punch. Place the circles on the head and trace around the bottom with a pen to make the eyes. Draw eyelashes. Sponge edges and darken cheeks.

Halo: Punch a ¾" hole in the glimmer paper and then use the 1" punch to make the halo with the bottom part thinner than the top of the halo. Make a 2nd halo to match for the back. Sandwich the silver thread hanger between the front and back of the halo.

Dress: Punch two bow sections and four tail sections with the Builder Bow Punch. Roll each bow section in half and glue ends together with glue dot. Layer two tail sections for the front gluing top edges where they overlap slightly. Glue this section to a piece of doily and cut to make the petticoat. Glue the other two tail sections to the back of the petticoat. Cut a little section of red vellum for the top as shown in the picture above.

Hands: Use the punched out pieces from the Curvy Corner Trio Punch for hands. Use tweezers and a dot of Tombow glue to attach to inside of sleeves.

Dress Decoration: The glimmer paper background is cut with the largest circle of the Owl Punch. Loop the silver thread by making a large, medium and then small loop on top of a glue dot which holds the thread in place. Secure with a second glue dot on top of thread and then add the Enamel Dot. Use Dotto or a fancy clip to hold the angel in place until she is removed to use as an ornament. SAL
