

Waterfall Card

<u>Stamp Sets</u>: Petite Pairs Delicate Doilies <u>Paper:</u> Whisper White, Melon Mambo, Flirtatious Specialty DSP

Ink: Melon Mambo

Accessories: White brads, Scallop Dots Ribbon

<u>Tools:</u> Ribbon Horizontal Slot punch, Mat Pack, Paper Piercer, bone folder, scissors, adhesive, paper cutter.

Main Card: Whisper White 5 ½" x 8 ½", Score at 4 ¼"

1st Layer: DSP $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 4"

Inside Layer: Melon Mambo 5 1/4" x 4"

(I used one cut out doily DSP to enhance)

Waterfall Strip: Whisper White 9" x 2"

Score Strip at: -----2"------ 2 3/4 "------3 1/2 "------4 1/4" (3/4" intervals)

Front Belt: Melon Mambo 1" x 4 1/4" Goes out to edge of card

Bottom Squares: Melon Mambo (4) 2" x 2"

Top Squares: Whisper White (4) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4"

Ribbon: Melon Mambo Scallop Dots 3" folded in half

Attach the belt to the DSP using only the brads. The belt ends at 7/8" above bottom of the DSP. The brad is $\frac{1}{2}$ " down and $\frac{1}{2}$ " in on the sides of the belt-easy to line up on the mat pack- over 3 holes, down 3 holes in the second section.

When gluing the bottom squares, put snail adhesive on the white ³/₄" sections and attach the **top** ³/₄" of the square. Slide the waterfall strip under the belt and once again, put the glue on the belt and attach the **bottom** 1" of the waterfall section.

I've seen this card so many different ways. Use it sideways and/or put on little pictures to make a quick album. Use words at the bottom of each section to make a fun greeting, for example Hi Happy Birthday Sister.
