



Mystery Card

Challenge #17

Start by picking one Designer Series Paper (DSP) with a coordinating front and back, then choose two coordinating cardstocks, one for the base and one for a layer that is light enough to stamp on.

*Designer Series Paper (DSP)

- 3" X 11"
- 5" X 1"

-Score the 11" DSP at 1 ½, 2, 3, 3 ½, 4 ½, 5, 6, 6 ½, 7 ½, 8, 9, 9 ½

-Pencil Mark the 1 ½ " half point on both sides of the 3" length

-Pencil Mark the 5" and 6" points on the 11" length

-Cut diagonally from the 1 ½ mark to the 5" mark on the left and 1 ½" mark to 6" mark on right

-Fan fold working from the middle to each side. The middle inch lies flat at the back.

*Coordinating Cardstock

- 8 1/2" X 5 ½", Scored at 4 ¼"

*Layer of Light Coordinating Cardstock

- 4" X 5 ¼"
- 4" X 5 ¼" for inside

Choose a large stamp that will stamp on the top 1 ½" of the layer of cardstock and an ink dark enough to show on your choice of colored layer. Embellish with a bow from a 12" ribbon or die cut an image.

Adhesives including tear and tape
