

Challenge #6

Card Type: Triangle Tri Fold Card - a card that twists from portrait to landscape Creator: Twila Davis on Splitcoast Stampers (http://splitcoaststampers.com/)

- Base-Cardstock: 10 1/4" X 8"
 - Score at 5 1/2" on long side (note: leaves 4 ¾" so it is not half)
 - o Cut in half (4") on 8" side
 - On the short 4 ¾" make a pencil mark at 4"- SCORE from point to mark
 - Repeat on second half of base
 - Flip one of the halves over and glue the two halves together in middle so there is a triangle fold on the top left & bottom right
- Triangle Mat-Coordinating cardstock 3 ¾" X 3 ¾" cut in half diagonally
- DSP Triangle Top- 3 ½ X 3 ½ cut in half diagonally (be careful with directional DSP remembering that the card is portrait)
- Coordinating DSP X 2 3 ¾" X 4 ¼"
 - o Tricky fold your card base to portrait and then fold down a triangle
 - Lay your DSP on the base 1/8" down for border at top and pencil a mark about 9/16" which should be 1/8" from the triangle fold
 - $\circ\ \ \,$ Cut the DSP from the point to the pencil mark
 - o Repeat on the other DSP piece
- Inside Mat 5 ¼" X 3 ¾"
- Inside Top 5 1/16" X 3 5/16"
 - o Stamp your desired greeting/image, layer on mat and mount to middle
- Focal Image on Front layered circles or die cut image or ??? your choice- just keep the image less than 3 ¼" X 3 ¼"- glue on after adding ribbon
- Ribbon: 24"

Cardstock, stamps, inks, and embellishments are up to you! Have fun! I look forward to seeing what you create!
