

Challenge #7

Card Type: Twisted Ribbon Card Technique

(note: I changed cuts to 1/8" reveal so the front left matched the reveal on the right)

- Base-Cardstock A: 5 ½" X 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" portrait card
 - Cut 2" off the 4 ¼" front side and cut the 2" piece to 1 7/8" X 5" for inside
- Front Mat: Coordinating Cardstock B, 2" X 5 ¼"
- Front Top: DSP, 1 3/4" X 5"
- Inside Mat: Coordinating Cardstock B, 4" X 5 ¼"
- Strip for faux ribbon: Cardstock A, 15/8" X 5"
 - Make pencil marks every ½" down both right and left sides of the strip
- Ribbon DSP:
 - Dark DSP, (X5) ½" X 2 ½"
 - Light DSP, (X6) ½" X 2 ½"
 - Place top of dark DSP at corner of top left and the bottom edge of that ribbon at the 2nd pencil mark on right
 - o Repeat with top of each dark ribbon piece placed on the left pencil mark





- Layer light ribbon DSP pieces from the right to the left, corner to corner, note the first and last pieces are off the strip
- Let adhesive dry and then turn to back side and cut off excess
- Greeting- Your choice of dies and greetings
 - Mat, Karen used the Coordinating Cardstock B & Stylish Shapes Squares
 - Top, Karen used the Cardstock A & Stylish Shapes Squares

Cardstock, stamps, inks, and embellishments are up to you! Have fun! I look forward to seeing what you create!

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
