Challenge #9

Card Type: Recessed Panel Card

- Base-Cardstock: 4" X 11" scored at 5 ½" portrait card the long way
 - Pencil Mark a dot at ¾" and 1 ½" on left side of the front
 - o Pencil Mark a dot at 3" and bottom corner on right side of the front
 - Cut the front from the ¾" dot on left to the 3" dot on the right
 - $\circ~$ Cut the front again from the 3" dot on the left to the right corner -5 % "
- Panel Mat: Coordinating Cardstock, 4" X 5 1/2"
 - o Pencil Mark a dot at 7/8" and 1 3/8" on left side
 - o Pencil Mark a dot at 3 1/8" and 5 3/8" on right side
 - $\circ~$ Cut the mat from the 7/8" dot on left to the 3 1/8" dot on the right
 - O Cut the mat again from the 1 3/8" dot on the left to the 5 3/8" on the right
- Inside Mat: neutral for your greeting, 3 ¾ X 5 ¼
- Inside Bottom Strip: DSP, 3 ¾ X 1/2
- Designer Series Paper (DSP) for the recessed panel: 4" X 5 ½"
 - Note: if your DSP is directional be sure it is mounted so that when the card is opened the direction is correct on the inside

Adhere the two mat pieces to your DSP then adhere the card base top to the mat and then add the bottom cut of the card base

The video shows how Francie uses the leftover cut outs of the base and mat to make another card. She also shows cuts for a standard portrait card. Stamps and embellishments are up to you. Have fun! I look forward to seeing what you create!
